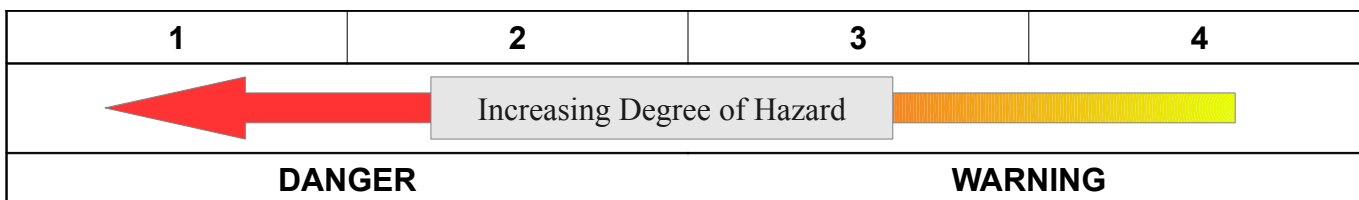
Pictograms

	Exclamation Point	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Irritation (skin/eyes) • Skin Sensitization • Acute Toxicity (harmful) • Single Exposure / Target Organ Toxicity (drowsiness, respiratory irritation) • Hazardous to the Ozone Layer
	Corrosion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrosive (skin/eyes) • Corrosive to metals
	Silhouette or Health Hazard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carcinogenicity • Respiratory Sensitization • Reproductive Toxicity • Single or Repeated Exposure Toxicity • Mutagenicity • Aspiration Hazard
	Skull & Crossbones	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acute Toxicity (fatal or toxic)
	Flame	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flammable • Self-Reactive • Pyrophoric • Self-Heating • Water Contact, Emits Flammable Gases • Organic Peroxide
	Flame Over Circle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oxidizer
	Exploding Bomb	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explosive • Self-Reactive (severe) • Organic Peroxide (severe)
	Gas Cylinder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gas Under Pressure

	Environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hazards to the Aquatic Environment (acute or chronic)
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Hazard Categories and Signal Words

Each Hazard may be divided into several Categories and its severity noted by a Signal Word.

DANGER

Hazard Statements:
 Combustible liquid
 Causes severe skin burns and eye damage
 May cause drowsiness or dizziness
 May be corrosive to metals
 Harmful to aquatic life with long lasting effects

Precautionary Statements:
Prevention: Keep away from flames and hot surfaces. – No smoking. • Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection. • Do not breathe mists. • Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. • Wash hands/skin thoroughly after handling. • Keep only in original container.
Response: In case of fire: Use water/carbon dioxide/foam/water spray to extinguish. • If swallowed: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. • If on skin (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. • If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. • Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. • If inhaled: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. • Immediately call a poison center/doctor/hospital. • Absorb spillage to prevent material damage. • Collect spillage.
Storage: Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool. Keep container tightly closed. • Store locked up. • Store in corrosive resistant container with a resistant inner liner.
Disposal: Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/ regional/ national/international regulations.
